



Mandated Reporters

Reports of Abuse

All staff members at LiFT, including the front office staff, Facilities team, Administrative empoloyees, as well as the educational staff, are Mandated Reporters. As such, any report of abuse is handled to the fullest extent allowable by law.

Bullying

LiFT takes any report of bullying seriously. Bullying will be defined as unwanted, aggressive behavior which is repeated, over time, and involves an imbalance of power. Bullying includes actions such as making threats, spreading rumors, attacking someone physically or verbally, and excluding someone from a group on purpose. Bullying will be responded to swiftly by all acting authorities in our discipline process. LiFT holds a Zero Tolerance for bullying, and it may result in suspension and/or expulsion.
